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# AS2Protocol Assertion (Custom) - User Documentation

# AS/2 Protocol Assertion

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# Overview

The AS/2 Protocol assertion provides the functionality needed to build up policies that conform to the AS/2 protocol specification.

# **Background**

The gateway currently lacks the ability to generate and verify Message Disposition Notifications (MDN's). AS/2 responses may contain an MDN that the client can process to verify that the server received the message correctly.

# Installation

# **Pre-Requisites**

- The API Management Gateway appliance is correctly configured and in operation
- The API Management Gateway Policy Manager is installed
- The S/MIME Assertion is installed on the gateway

### **How-To Install**

### 9.0 and above

- 1. In Policy Manager, go to Tasks > Extensions and Add-Ons > Manage Server Module Files
- 2. Click Upload to upload the AS2ProtocolAssertion-[version].sjar
- 3. Provide the assertion a name like AS2Protocol and click OK. This name is used in the Manage Server Files dialog
- 4. The assertion will be uploaded and loaded onto the Gateway. For more information on managing Server Module Files, see CA API Gateway Manage Server Module Files

# Prior to 9.0

1. Delete any existing copies of the AS2ProtocolAssertion-[version].jar from the following directory on the Gateway machine:

/opt/SecureSpan/Gateway/runtime/modules/lib

2. Copy the new AS2ProtocolAssertion-[version].jar to the following directory on the Gateway machine:

/opt/SecureSpan/Gateway/runtime/modules/lib

3. Set the ownership and permission for the file:

chown layer7:layer7 AS2ProtocolAssertion-[version].aar
chmod 444 AS2ProtocolAssertion-[version].aar

4. Restart the Gateway:

service ssg restart

Once the AS/2 Protocol Assertion is enabled, you will see the following new items on the Policy Manager interface:

AS2 Attach MDN, AS2 Verify MDN, Calculate Hash and AS2 Extract MDN Attribute in the Message Validation/Transformation category




# **Usage**

# **Using AS2 Attach MDN**

The AS2 Attach MDN Assertion will generate a Message Disposition Notification and include it in the target message. The target message is wrapped in a MIME multipart message, with the first part being the original message and the second part being the MDN.

To add the assertion to the Policy Development window, see Adding an Assertion in the Policy Authoring User Manual.

When adding the assertion, the *Attach MDN Properties* dialog will automatically appear; when modifying the assertion, right-click *AS2 Attach MDN Properties* in the policy window and select *Attach MDN Properties* or double click the assertion in the policy window. The assertion properties are displayed.




Option	Description
Message Variable	To scan request messages, enter <i>request</i> . To scan response messages, enter <i>response</i> . Enter the context variable name to scan the messages. By default, this is set to <i>request</i> . This field is required.
Original Recipient	The original recipient of the MDN. This field is optional.
Final Recipient	The final recipient of the MDN. This field is optional.
Message ID	The message ID of the AS/2 request message.
MIC Algorithm	The algorithm that was used to calculate the hash of the AS/2 request message.
Hash Value	The value of the hash of the AS/2 request message.

### **Using AS2 Verify MDN**

The AS2 Verify MDN Assertion is used to verify the content of a Message Disposition Notification and optionally strip it from the target message. In order to verify the MDN, some information about the AS/2 request message is required and is provided to this assertion through context variables.

To add the assertion to the Policy Development window, see Adding an Assertion in the Policy Authoring User Manual.

When adding the assertion, the AS2 Verify MDN Properties dialog will automatically appear; when modifying the assertion, right-click AS2 Verify MDN Properties in the policy window and select AS2 Verify MDN Properties or double click the assertion in the policy window. The assertion properties are displayed.




Option	Description
Message Variable	To scan request messages, enter <i>request</i> . To scan response messages, enter <i>response</i> . Enter the context variable name to scan the messages. By default, this is set to <i>request</i> . This field is required.
Message ID	The message ID of the AS/2 request message, not the message containing the cMDN.
SHA-1 Hash Value	The SHA-1 hash of the AS/2 request message that was computed locally. This cfield is optional if MD5 Hash Value was provided.
MD5 Hash Value	The MD5 hash of the AS/2 request message that was computed locally. This field is optional if SHA-1 Hash Value was provided.
Header Lines Variable	If Remote MDN is checked, then the headers of the MDN portion of the MIME multipart message are stored in a variable with this name. Not used if Remote MDN is not checked.
Remove MDN	If checked, then the target message is set to the first part of the MIME multipart message.

# **Using Calculate Hash**

The Calculate Hash Assertion can be used to calculate the SHA-1 or MD5 hash of a message with an optional prefix. The prefix can be headers that were removed earlier in policy.

To add the assertion to the Policy Development window, see Adding an Assertion in the Policy Authoring User Manual.

When adding the assertion, the Calculate Hash Properties dialog will automatically appear; when modifying the assertion, right-click Calculate Hash Properties in the policy window and select Calculate Hash Properties or double click the assertion in the policy window. The assertion properties are displayed.



Option Description


Message Variable	To scan request messages, enter <i>request</i> . To scan response messages, enter <i>response</i> . Enter the context variable name to scan the messages. By default, this is set to <i>request</i> . This field is required.	
Hash Type	The algorithm to use for computing the hash value. Can be SHA-1 or MD5.	
Output Variable Name	The name of the context variable to store the result in.	
Prefix	A prefix to attach to prepend to the target message before calculating the hash value.	

# **Using AS2 Extract MDN Attribute**

The AS2 Extract MDN Attribute Assertion can be used to extract information from the MDN payload in an AS/2 response message.

To add the assertion to the Policy Development window, see Adding an Assertion in the Policy Authoring User Manual.

When adding the assertion, the Extract MDN Attribute Properties dialog will automatically appear; when modifying the assertion, right-click Extract MDN Attribute Properties or double click the assertion in the policy window. The assertion properties are displayed.



Option	Description		
Message Variable	To scan request messages, enter <i>request</i> . To scan response messages, enter <i>response</i> . Enter the context variable name to scan the messages. By default, this is set to <i>request</i> . This field is required.		
Attribute Name	The key for the attribute value to retrieve.		
Output Variable Name	The name of the context variable to store the result in.
