- Enhancements are delivered disabled where possible to give you more control
  over when and how the features are implemented. With new features disabled,
  you control when to make the new features available for use in your
  environment. An explicit action is required to enable the feature.
- Product validation programs are available so that you can influence feature
  design and test new features and capabilities before they are made generally

- Individual product fixes are provided when needed, separate from product features. You can apply product fixes without enabling new features, which limits exposure to additional features being applied in a production environment.

Continuous Delivery releases are generally available, and customers are fully supported when running on the CD release.
