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CA TDM Upgrade – Best Practices

• Before Upgrade

- *Log a Support Ticket for Broadcom assistance*
- *Refer to the Upgrade Procedure listed in Reference Section*
- *Identify the Test Cases to be tested after the upgrade*
Example: Project, Generator, Publish Jobs, Self Service Catalog, FDM Job etc.
- *Make Sure your OrientDb and TDM Portal Services are shutdown*
- *Make Sure TDoD and Remote Publish Services are shutdown*
- *Backup the TDM Repository*
- *Backup below folders*
 - C:\Program Files\CA\CA Test Data Manager Portal
 - C:/ProgramData/CA/CA Test Data Manager
 - C:\Grid-Tools
- *Cleanup the logs*
- *Inform the teams about the TDM downtime*

NOTE: TDM Repository is upgraded through TDM Portal from 4.6

CA TDM Upgrade – Best Practices


- **During Upgrade**

- *Make Sure all the Services are Shutdown*
- *Run the TDMPortal.exe -> Run as Administrator*
- *Default TDM and OrientDb Services are started after upgrade*
- *Log into the TDM Portal and check the version is correct*
- *Run the GTServer.exe -> Run as Administrator*
- *Log into DataMaker and validate the TDM version*

- **Post Upgrade**

- *Run the pre planned validation test cases*
- *Contact Broadcom Support if there are any issues*
- *If there are no issues and upgrade is successful, notify the team*
