




How to JOIN the Gen EDGE Community

1. Go to Gen EDGE Community here:

2. Click the JOIN button.
 - a. You must be logged in to the Broadcom Community site.
3. You will be offered Community Notification settings. Select "Include" and frequency of Real Time or Daily.
4. Click "Yes join the community".





How to update your community NOTIFICATION settings

2. Click "Settings"
 - a. You must be logged in to the Broadcom Community site. After you "JOIN" the Gen EDGE Community, you will have the "Settings" button.
3. Click "Manage Notifications"
4. Scroll down to "Notification Settings"
5. Select the frequency for which you would like to receive emails. You can also click within a column to toggle on/off the inclusion of Gen EDGE in your Community summary.

How to submit a Community IDEA for Gen

1. Go to the IDEAS section in your Broadcom Community site.

2. Select "Add".
3. Fill in the form. Include a title, description with business need, select "Gen" for the category.
4. Click "Save" to submit your idea.
 - a. If this is your first Idea ever, the community admin may have to approve you idea.
 - b. The Product Owner will review your idea within 30 days, share to the Gen EDGE Community, and update the status to "Ready for Voting". For more about the process, check out the documents on the Ideas home page.
