


Broadcom Community Ideas

Status Definitions

"Ideas" is a forum in the Broadcom Communities where customers can post, vote, and comment on enhancement requests. The product team will update the status to show where an idea is in the life cycle. Below is that life cycle and status definitions.



Status Definitions

- **Submitted (open)** This is the default status when an idea is submitted.
- Ready for Voting (open) The idea has been seen by the product team. The idea will be monitored and reviewed for prioritization.

Best Practice Include your problem and a clear business value in the idea description.

- Committed (open) The product team is committed to delivering this idea. The timeline for delivery will vary, but this status usually indicates the idea will be delivered relatively soon. The development, release and timing remain at Broadcom's sole discretion and can change at any time.
- **Delivered (closed)** The idea has been delivered. Comments can elaborate on whether we delivered partial solutions, alternative solutions, or if the feature already exists.
- Rejected (closed) This is a clear indication that we will not be implementing the idea. Many
 factors lend to rejecting an idea including customer value, strategic relevance, and technical
 feasibility.
- **Not Top Priority (closed)** This status is for ideas in that grey area where it's right on the border of being a top priority, but unlikely we'll be able to deliver within the next three years. It is recommended that we use this status sparingly.
- **Duplicate (closed)**: This idea already exists.
