
Managing Groups

Login as Administrator


Navigate to Configuration > User Groups

Example: Admin-NewProject and Tester-NewProject Groups are created automatically




Creating New Group

And Save




You see, New Group Tester1-NewProject is created.




Delete the User Group



Confirm Delete to Delete the Group




Now, you see the Tester1-New Project Group is removed


Login as Administrator

Creating Admin user for the Project:


We can create a Admin user only for the particular Project



Login with new Admin Account




You have only NewProject for administration and you will find all the available functions






Adding Additional Functions to the Tester Group

Login as NewProject_Tester1 - You will have the access to create Variables



Enabling the Register Objects in Modeling -


Note: In the below diagram, Register table is not selected
