Rally Unresponsive

The following is a detailed accounting of the service outage that Rally users experienced on August 02th, 2021.

Root Cause Analysis Summary

| Root Cause | A behavior change in our upstream provider CloudFlare caused the last-modified header to start being generated and sent to the browser. When the browser sees that header it will in turn send the corresponding If-Modified-Since header back to the origin server on subsequent requests. The web services API took the If-Modified-Since headers and used it in database queries as a last_updated > :date: criteria. This resulted in an empty result set, in most cases, leading to empty pages in the UI. |
