
Reclaiming space in the Symantec Data Loss Database

1. If you are using a single-tier deployment of Symantec Data Loss Prevention, The file location of DLP_Lobspace_reclaim.sql is c:\SymantecDLP\Protect\install\sql folder.



2. On the computer that hosts your Oracle 11g Standard database, open a command shell and navigate to the location of the DLP Lobspace reclaim.sql file.

3. Log in to SQL*Plus as the Oracle sysdba: sqlplus sys/ <password> as sysdba





4. At the SQL*Plus prompt, run the utility: @@DLP_lobspace_reclaim.sql
