Issue:	The SEP management console runs on Java v1.5.x. If a later version is installed on the target system the install will fail. The installation program indicates that the later versions of Java need to be uninstalled.
Solution:	A workaround is outlined below that circumvents the need to uninstall Java.

1. Open the Java Control Panel from within the Windows Control Panel





- 3. Disable ALL the versions listed. Some of the listings under the system tab may be locked to changes.
- 4. Proceed with a new install of the SEP console from <u>HTTP://{SEP Management Server}:9090</u>.
- 5. Once the console has been installed, re-enable all the versions.
