A: No they aren't linked in this way – if test or test suite finished with failed status, the build get "unstable" (yellow color); if test or test suite fails to run or finish for whatever reason (cannot connect to DevTest, malformed mar file,...) the build is marked as failed (red color).

Q: is it posible to parametrize the simulator name on which the testcase/suite has to be staged like how we are giving the vse name in case of virutualization

A: yes - right now, all the data is stored in the MAR file, so if you'd like to change the config, you can do it in the MAR file and run the tests from there. In future we would to provide ability to define these parameters at runtime without the need to change metadata in MAR file.
