 - The disaster recovery process can now be automated using the provided Ansible playbooks. The automated disaster recovery process includes automated product installation, backup and restoration of data to a designated secondary site (Data Center)
- Ability to collect CCS logs, configure log severity and log level using CCS Console.
- Ability to perform silent uninstallation of CCS Agents.
- Ability to target specific CCS Managers within a site for Asset import and Agents jobs.
- Agent Registration Utility to accept multiple CCS Managers for Agent registration for better reliability and redundancy during the agent registration process.
- Ability to include asset groups in Agent Management Job
- Create Job and Update Job APIs to include additional scheduling properties
- New API for searching jobs using different job properties
- The CCS installation is now supported on Microsoft Windows Server 2022.
- Red Hat Enterprise Linux 8 PPC Little Endian (LE) Agent is now provided for data collection using CCS
