Re: Security Vulnerability in GNU Bash shell

Attention On-Premises Administrators:

You are receiving this message because you have been identified as a point of contact regarding our Rally On-Premises solution deployments.

We are closely monitoring the critical vulnerability in the GNU Bash shell (CVE-2014-6271) that was released yesterday, September 24, 2014. This vulnerability is present in the vast majority of Unix and Linux systems, including Apple's OS X, and in many common configurations this vulnerability is exploitable over the network. This vulnerability could allow an attacker to execute commands on an affected system. Yesterday, many of the affected platforms released patches for this vulnerability, but it was quickly determined that the patches were an incomplete fix to the vulnerability (CVE-2014-7169). We are monitoring for the release of the new patches and will send an update once those are available.

Through our assessment of the vulnerability, we have determined that On-Premises solution deployments are affected. Customers with Internet facing deployments of the On-Premise solution should maintain diligence in monitoring web server logs for any suspicious activity. If you are not exposing your On-Premise installation to the Internet, your risk is significantly reduced.
