Tracy Ma to Everyone: Import process flow chart from Visio, which is the right way that no need manually adjust again by myself in ARD ?

Melanie Giuliani to Everyone: @Tracy - with regards to Visio, we have improved the Visio importer very recently (should be available in the next year). Now we will inherit the layout of what you import. There are some issues still, that Ben is going over on the line.

Tracy Ma to Everyone: Could you show me what I should do next for generate test cases after the process flow is ready ?

Melanie Giuliani to Everyone: @Tracy - Ben is showing an example starting at roughly 13:00 on the recording. Recording timestamps for the transcript :)

Tracy Ma to Everyone: Could I add the missing info. into Excel which is exported from ARD , then reload the test case back to ARD?

Melanie Giuliani to Everyone: @No, we don't have a method of doing that. But James would argue that it's not necessary bc, if you noticed, when James was generating test cases, he had quite a small diagram and it was scaling up quite significantly. You'll notice that for any of the test cases on the diagram, he has every piece of test data set because they can be set up at the block level and then inherited.

Melanie Giuliani to Everyone: James is updating on the TFS integration. We have a validation program coming that will allow you to take a look at the prototype. Please reach out to a member of the Product team or myself for more info on that!

Tracy Ma to Everyone: What you think ARD can help on our test job before ARD integrated with TFS ?

Melanie Giuliani to Everyone: @Tracy – can you please provide more info?

Tracy Ma to Everyone: write test cases in TFS, but ARD is not ready to integrate with TFS yet.

Melanie Giuliani to Everyone: @Tracy - if TFS can import in any way, xls export is how you can bridge the gap. ARD is a test case design tool, so if it turns out that you're designing them for a complicated system, it's not advised that you manually design them. Even without any hard integration, you can

design test cases for what you need to cover, even if you have to manually put them into TFS, that would still be an advantage.
