 - Track DevOps assets in an extensible CMDB, with supporting REST queries designed to feed and provide dynamic input to DevOps workflows
 - Integrate Changesets in popular Agile PPM tools such as CA Agile Central or Atlassian JIRA, based on OOTB workflows for consumption of CA Endeavor SCM webhooks
 - Trigger downstream DevOps tools such as Jenkins from Agile PPM or CA Endeavor SCM events
- CA Endeavor SCM integration plugins for Enterprise GIT repositories – **now supporting Enterprise GitHub repositories**
 - Sync changes between designated branches to corresponding SYSTEM/SUBSYSTEMs
 - Collaborate with users working on CA Endeavor SCM via the Eclipse plugin or ISPF / QuickEdit
 - Take advantage of GIT features for mainframe development including “Pull Requests”, automated merge, and integrations to most IDEs on the market
 - Support for Atlassian Bitbucket and Enterprise GitHub repositories
 - Local builds of working directories without commit or push to the enterprise server via an included Zowe CLI script
