

Chapter 2: Inspector View Improvements


Multiple Inspector View Tabs

In Devtest 10.2, we have made changes to enable multiple inspector view tabs for virtual services. Prior to this, the inspector view used to come up as a popup which was a constraint for teams who wanted to view inspection view for multiple services by switching between them. Having multiple inspector view tabs helps team by enabling them to switch between tabs easily, thereby potentially improving productivity for them. Please find more information on the feature below.



- As shown above, we can now open multiple Inspector view tabs for virtual services.
- The Inspector view has now been changed from being a popup to a tab.
- The teams can now switch between inspector view for services easily by switching between the tabs.


VSE Identifier



- As shown above, we now have an identifier which will help identify the VSE to which the virtual service has been deployed.
- This is helpful for teams to identify the VSE to which a virtual service has been deployed while looking at the inspection view. (in multi VSE environment)

Ability to Resize


With the new portal layout, we now can resize Argument key / value pairs. This will make it easier to view long values.



- With the new layout, we can resize the Argument key and Argument value columns as well.
- This will enable us to view large values by resizing the columns.

Unknown Step Scenarios


Improved scenarios where unknown step information was being shown earlier. Now, there will be few unknown step names in inspector view for virtual services.



Chapter 3: Session Data View Improvements

Tab View


Session Data view has been changed from a popup to a tab view.



- Session Data view has been changed from a popup to a tab view as shown above.
- This will enable teams to view session tracking information for multiple services by switching between tabs.

Resizers

The changes made to the session tracking view enables teams to resize the different sections.



- The changes made to the session tracking view enables us to resize the sections within the view.
- This will help teams to resize and view the needed information.

Expand / Collapse


In DevTest 10.2, we can expand / collapse the request / response information in session data view screen.



Chapter 4: VSE Monitor Improvements

Group Tag Drop down

In DevTest 10.2 portal, the group tab in Virtual service inspector view is now a drop down where users can choose the group with which to filter the view.



- As shown above, the group tag is now a drop down where users can choose the group by which to filter the view.
- Prior to this, users had to type the value, which can be difficult, if there are a lot of groups.
- The drop-down feature enables users to choose the group names instead of typing.

V2 Recordings View


The service inspector view in DevTest 10.2 now also shows V2 recorders information.



Chapter 5: Create VS Improvements

Create VS Landing Page

In DevTest 10.2 portal, Create VS Landing page now opens as a separate tab.



- Create VS landing page now opens in a separate tab in portal.
- This will enable users to setup recorder along with performing other operation by switching between tabs. This will also ensure consistency in the way screens are presented within portal.
