

Focus Areas of APM Command Center



ACC can be distilled into 4 distinct areas

Diagnostics



View Information about Java Agents running within the environment

Remotely fetch Agent Log Files and other diagnostic information

Package diagnostics for upload to support ticket

Remotely change the Log Level on a single Java Agent

Configuration

Create configuration policies (tailored package)

API based package delivery

Audit trail of configuration changes

Ability to create configuration groups

Support for remote 'cold' and 'hot' configuration

Deployment

Ability to create packages tailored to the environment

Support for Field Packs in Agent Packages

Packages exposed via API for use by 3rd Party deployment tools

Cloud based store for Agent related packages

Health

Review the monitoring overhead of the agents


Report issues / errors with the monitoring

Suggest changes to the monitoring to reduce overhead

Suggest additional monitoring opportunities



10.3/10.4 – enhancing configuration capabilities

- Next major target is to distribute packages to agents / application servers directly from ACC
 - Requires number of distinct sub-features
- User Groups and Roles
 - Includes integration with LDAP Services
- Dynamic Agent Groups
 - Ability to assign Agent to group based on rules
 - User roles can then be assigned to a group
- Deployment of agents to systems
 - Ability to push packages (from 10.2) to target systems
- Change Auditing
 - REST API exposed details of changes by user, date, etc.
